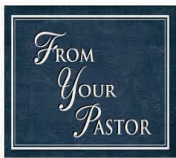

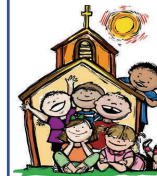


Ski Trip: Ski Trip has been rescheduled for Saturday February 2nd. Leave the church at 8:30 a.m.
