1. Three 14:25-27

B Your Cross. 14:27
C Your Possessions. 14:33 Jesus is not saying that we must away everything we have, but He is saying we must be to do so if necessary.
<b>2. Three 14:28-35</b> Jesus tells 3 short
A. The Builder. 14:28-30 One who is committed to Jesus must what he starts.
B. The King Going to 14:31-33 Following requires a matter.
C. The Salt In 14:34-35 If you are not as a Christian, then you are not a real disciple.  Jesus never promised that the Christian life would be, but
He did promise that, whatever it costs, it's it to follow Him.
