In Genesis 39, Joseph ended up in prison, not for doing something
, but for doing something Joseph spent years in prison
learning a very important lesson - God's are not His denials. When
God makes you a promise, sometimes He also makes you for that promise
to be fulfilled (Psalm 27:14).
Some Bible characters who had to wait for a promise to be fulfilled
were: (75 years), (25 years), and (15 years).
Sometimes God develops our by forcing us to wait on Him.

we're waiting on God.
1. He Never Became
Joseph never stopped the Lord. He became the
