

# “God Has Big Plans For You”

## Jeremiah 1:4-10

God says to Jeremiah in verse 5, “I know who you are, I \_\_\_\_\_ you with special gifts and abilities, and I have a purpose for your life.” Those 3 things are not just true of Jeremiah, they are true of \_\_\_\_\_ person on earth.

Three \_\_\_\_\_ in verse 5 describe 3 aspects of God’s purpose for Jeremiah. Those three verbs also describe how God reveals His plan today.

### 1. He \_\_\_\_\_ You. 1:5

### 2. He \_\_\_\_\_ You. 1:5

### 3. He \_\_\_\_\_ You Apart. 1:5
